

Instructions for Gainsborough Passage Set

Installation procedures for Gainsborough Passage set when used in conjunction with Gainsborough Dual Sprung latches for internal doors 33mm - 40mm (1 1/4" - 1 5/8") in thickness. For thicker doors, up to 50mm (2"), you will require an extended screw and spindle kit (KT125).


- 1. Scribe drilling centres using appropriate template (see below).
- 2. Drill door as shown at Fig. 1/1a for 3 hole Dual Sprung latch system, or as shown in Fig.2/2a for 3 hole straddle latch system. Mark and chisel latch face and fit latch.
- 3. Insert short screws through 2 small holes and attach the 2 posts to underside of one fixing plate.
- 4. Insert posts through door and latch, fit 2nd plate, ensure central fitting and secure with long screws.
- 5. Insert spindle through the latch and screw the door knob assemblies to fixing plates until roses make firm contact with door.
